- The Government of Finland has set an ambitious climate target to become carbon neutral by 2035 and carbon negative after that.
- VTT has coordinated multidisciplinary research projects to create alternative narratives and quantitative scenario assessments to research climate and energy targets.





Alternative narratives to visualize different global development paths


- Four alternative storylines with different assumptions on economic structure, community structure, human behaviour, clean technology development, etc. in Finland
 - 1. Continuous Growth
 - 2. Save
 - 3. Change
 - 4. Stagnation




Alternative storylines to study both GHG mitigation and LULUCF*





Using different narratives and storylines helps to better identify potential risks and opportunities


