IRENA's LTES Network members and partners showcase experience and best practices from national institutions

BACKGROUND

IRENA's "Long-term Energy Scenarios Network" (LTES Network) provides a platform for national and regional energy scenario practitioners to share experience and good practices in using and developing scenarios. As of mid-2021, the network gathers 25 country members and 10 technical partners and has hosted over 30 events. In its first year, the LTES Network organised a 1st webinar series that featured its members and technical partners. Following the series' success, the 2nd round of webinars will feature new members and partners who have joined since 2020. Improving scenario use

Key Question:

How can scenarios be better used for strategic decision-making by governments and investors? 03

Identifying capacity-building approaches

Key Question:

What approaches can enhance institutional capacity for scenario planning?
